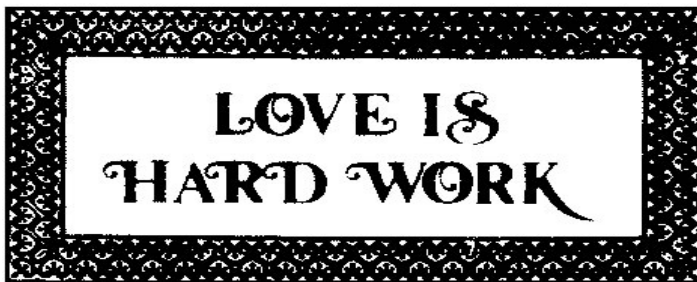

St. Rose Bridge Ministry

Our mission is to assist St. Rose parishioners having financial difficulties. We provide limited monetary assistance as funds allow and/or referrals to other local resources. All personal information is kept in utmost confidence. Surplus funds are given to non-parishioners in the Murfreesboro area. Please call BRIDGE at 692-0159 on Tuesdays between 10:00 a.m. and noon. Mission Team Goes to Haiti

The first half of our mission team leaves Friday, February 10. They are: Marion Sheehan, Marla West, Micki Parsley, Mike Jones, Rusty Vance and Jim Centanni. They will conduct classes: neo-natal care; safe delivery for midwives; sex education; hygiene and first aid for school children and staff; and electrical safety. Throughout their stay they will work to provide electricity to the Rose-Merci Clinic by: digging 300 foot-long trench to bury the cable; completing the storage room and installing 4 batteries, 2 chargers, and an inverter; connecting the 12.5K generator to the units in the power storage room and the run to the Clinic; and, installing switch covers, outlet covers, and ceiling light fixtures in the Clinic.

The second half of the team leaves on Tuesday, February 14. They are Dr. Bob & Debbie Dray, Dr. Rich and Aliene Parrish, Dr. Andy Brown, Bob Musgrove, Larry Audley and Ryan Parawan. They will work to heal the sick that come to the Rose-Merci Clinic and provide house calls for those who cannot come to the Clinic. Dr. Gerald Louis (Haitian) and the clinic staff will assist our team in caring for patients. Careful records will be kept. Depending on the needs, they hope to see 150 to 200 patients each day.

Six excellent translators will work with our team members so that they can do their very best work under difficult circumstances. Fr. Andre and Fr. Michel will pick up the team members at the airport. Both pastors welcome the St. Rose ambassadors to their second home—Haiti!

This mission is yours—every parishioner who attends church at St. Rose. It is through your generosity that we can provide for some basic needs in Haiti. Please note that all team members pay their own expenses and do not use your donations given for Haiti.

Please pray for our St. Rose Mission Team. May they have a safe journey, strengthen their faith through service and nurture the hope they find among the faithful in Haiti.
