



Saint Rose of Lima - Household Growth


Average Annual Growth Rate 6.5%





Rutherford County - Population Growth

- Between 2010 and 2021, Rutherford county had the <u>largest growth of any county in Tennessee.</u>
- The population grew from 263,721 to 351,202
 - 88,461 residents or <u>33.2%</u>. (2.6% CAGR)
- The county is expected to grow about 2% a year for the next two decades.
 - In 20 years at 2% growth the population will increase another 48.6%.
- We have roughly six families per week joining the parish.

Saint Rose of Lima School

- We have roughly 400 students in Pre-K through 8th grade.
 - School could handle about 500 if some additional flex rooms were added
 - At 2% annual growth over the planning period, attendance would be 592 students
- PSR has over 325 students, 481 at end of planning period.
- There is a current critical need for storage space
- Current critical need for flex rooms








Gymnasium


- Built in 1963
- Existing basketball court is 5' short of regulation size
- Gym is heavily used for basketball and large group gathering space
- Restrooms are too small and not ADA compliant
- Overall functionality is limited

What has changed?

- Our need for parking was not fully met in the 2020 Masterplan
- Plan included adding school flex rooms but did not show classroom expansion.
- Plan did not specifically address school storage or janitorial space
- The 2020 plan shows a footprint for a single gym
- Population growth continues at a pace greater than 2%
- May 25th, 2023 Supreme Court decision may reduce the size of the wetland boundaries










Sketch - moving North








Saint Rose of Lima woodland and campus can be a visible sign of our *Faith* by showcasing the importance we place on Laudate Si' and Creation Care.

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





Results of Marian Center Feasibility Study

- While the existing building is relatively sound all interior walls are structural walls impacting how we could use the building
- The cost per SF to renovate is lower than new space, but we would need to add new space for ADA access making the total cost higher
- Building does not have central heat and air further reducing usable space







The cost for a smaller more efficient new building would be less than bringing the old building up to code and renovating it.



Decision Point



What is a "Community"

- Community is made up of three parts:
 - <u>Belonging</u> a space where individuals feel accepted, valued, and included. Being part of something larger than oneself—a spiritual family or a group of like-minded people.
 - <u>Connection</u> It's about forming bonds with fellow church members, sharing experiences, and supporting one another. This connection can happen through worship services, small groups, events, and social interactions.
 - <u>Shared Purpose</u> this purpose often revolves around faith, worship, service, and outreach.




