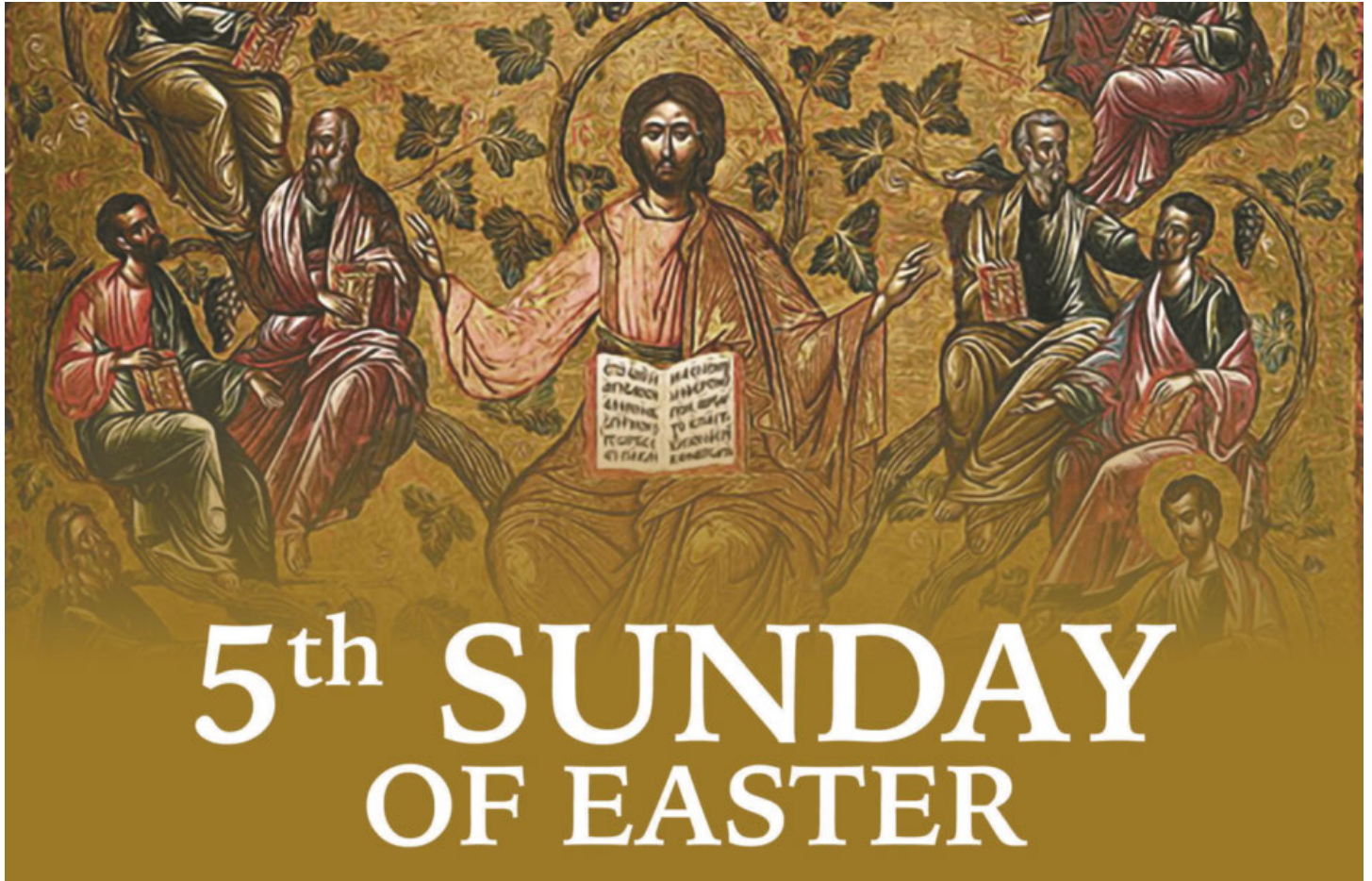

REMAIN IN ME

Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.

Jesus' order, "Remain in me", expresses a clear worry about the temptation of the disciples to stray or to stay in the superficiality of their relationship with him. To remain means to commit to the Master, to live His Word, and more, to follow His example, especially in our relationship with others.



To strive for this radicality, which is a characteristic of Jesus, our Master. He did not opt for superficial ways or stay halfway in his obedience to the Father and in fulfilling His mission. Rather, He went all the way, embraced all the consequences, and fulfilled all promises.

It is possible to see if a disciple remains in Jesus by the way he or she lives. As much as he remains in Him, the more he will identify himself with Him and his testimony will be powerful.

Bishop's Annual Appeal for Ministries

Q: What is the Appeal?

A: The Appeal is an essential fund-raising campaign, conducted annually, to benefit the entire Diocese of Nashville. Its purpose is to raise funds that support the Catholic mission. Every family or individual in the diocese plays a crucial role in supporting this vital initiative. It is through this drive, that we are called to share our gifts with others in need. Q: Where does the money go?

PATHWAY TO PROGRESS

Currently, we have six key program components in motion: the Master Plan and Funding, Marian Center, Athletic Field, Sanctuary, Columbarium, and New Gym.

Master Plan and Funding: We've presented the Master Plan to over a dozen different groups, receiving positive feedback. Engaging with various stakeholders has been fruitful, with constructive comments provided during and after the meetings. In May, we aim to meet with the Murfreesboro Planning Department to discuss our plans further. Funding: While our cash balance decreased this month due to our contribution of \$854,250 to the Diocese Legacy Campaign and design expenses, our cash total remains robust and continues to grow. However, all the funds needed for the Marian Center must be secured before construction can proceed. We're pleased to note the growing membership in the Hundred Dollar Heroes initiative, where households contribute \$100 monthly to support the program's endeavors.

Marian Center Renovation: Following the feasibility study's recommendation for a new facility, negotiations with Bauer Askew Architects for the design contract are underway. Their initial task will be to create a rendering of the proposed new building, expected in the coming weeks. Additionally, plans for a storage building on the 1522 Stonewall property are progressing. We need to provide the necessary survey and concept sketches to the Murfreesboro Planning Department for concurrence.

Athletic Field Relocation: The first steps in this project are to delineate the wetlands and identify key trees on the property. By law we must wait at least 48 hours after a rain to delineate wetlands. Given the rainy weather the past couple of weeks we have not made the progress we had hoped.

Columbarium: The committee met with the diocese to discuss our request to proceed with a feasibility study. We are waiting for approval from Bishop Spalding. Assuming he approves, the next step will be a survey parishioners for support.

Actualmente, tenemos seis componentes clave del programa en marcha: el Plan Maestro y Financiamiento, el Centro Mariano, el Campo Atlético, el Santuario, el Columbario y el Nuevo Gimnasio.

Plan Maestro y Financiamiento: Presentamos el Plan Maestro a más de una docena de grupos diferentes y recibimos comentarios positivos. La interacción con diversas partes interesadas ha sido fructífera y se han proporcionado comentarios constructivos durante y después de las reuniones. En mayo, nuestro objetivo es reunirnos con el Departamento de Planificación de Murfreesboro para discutir nuestros planes más a fondo. Financiamiento: Si bien nuestro saldo de efectivo disminuyó este mes debido a nuestra contribución de \$854,250 a la Campaña del Legado de la Diócesis y los gastos de diseño, nuestro total de efectivo sigue siendo sólido y continúa creciendo. Sin embargo, se deben obtener todos los fondos necesarios para el Centro Mariano antes de que pueda continuar la construcción. Nos complace observar la creciente membresía en la iniciativa Hundred Dollar Heroes, donde los hogares contribuyen con \$100 mensuales para apoyar los esfuerzos del programa.

Renovación del Marian Center: tras la recomendación del estudio de viabilidad para una nueva instalación, se están llevando a cabo negociaciones con Bauer Askew Architects para el contrato de diseño. Su tarea inicial será crear una representación del nuevo edificio propuesto, que se espera para las próximas semanas. Además, los planes para un edificio de almacenamiento en la propiedad 1522 Stonewall están avanzando. Necesitamos proporcionar los estudios y bocetos conceptuales necesarios al Departamento de Planificación de Murfreesboro para su aprobación.

Reubicación del campo deportivo: los primeros pasos de este proyecto son delinear los humedales e identificar árboles clave en la propiedad. Por ley debemos esperar al menos 48 horas después de una lluvia para delimitar los humedales. Debido al clima

Columbario: El comité se reunió con la diócesis para discutir nuestra solicitud de proceder con un estudio de viabilidad. Estamos esperando la aprobación del obispo Spalding. Suponiendo que lo apruebe, el siguiente paso será realizar una encuesta entre los feligreses para obtener apoyo.
